Frankley School Enrolment Scheme

Effective from 26 July 2021

The guidelines for the development and operation of enrolment schemes are issued under section 11G (3) of the Education Act 1989.

Home Zone

All students who live within the home zone described below and/or shown on the attached map shall be entitled to enrol at the school. Both sides of each road are included in the zone unless otherwise stated. Proof of residence within the home zone may be required.

Each year in August, applications for enrolment in the following year from in-zone students will be sought by a date which will be published in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school. This will enable the board to assess the number of places which can be made available to students who live outside the school zone.

Frankley School Enrolment Scheme Map and description

Both sides of each road are included in the zone.

- The zone commences at the corner of Tukapa Street and Frankley Road and proceeds north on Frankley Road until the intersection of Pike Place. The No Exit streets; Barclay Street and Clyde Street are in zone. 315 Frankley Road is also in zone.
- Turn northwest into Pike Place. Proceed along Pike Place to the end. All property numbers in Pike Place are in zone
- 3. The zone then proceeds northwest overland along the Francis Douglas Memorial College boundary to Julian Place.
- 4. The zone proceeds down Julian Place to the intersection of Tukapa Street. All properties in Julian Place are in zone
- 5. The zone turns west onto Tukapa Street. 177 Tukapa Street is in zone.

- 6. The zone proceeds along Tukapa Street to the intersection of Wallath Road.
- 7. The zone turns north onto Wallath Road, then proceeds along Wallath Road to the intersection of Wallath Road and Popular Grove. 1 and 2 Magnolia Drive and 34 Wallath Road are in zone.
- 8. The zone then turns west onto Poplar Grove to the intersection with Cyrus Street. 42 and 43 Poplar Grove are in zone.
- 9. The zone then proceeds along Cyrus Street to Fantome Place.
- 10. Turning right, the zone proceeds to the end of Fantome Place and returns to Cyrus Street. All properties on Fantome Place are in zone.
- 11. At the intersection of Fantome Place and Cyrus Street, the zone turns right and proceeds to the end of Cyrus Street.
- 12. The zone then proceeds in a straight line to the end of Elder Grove. All properties on Cyrus Street are in zone.
- 13. The zone then follows Elder Grover to the intersection of Elder Grove and Karamea Street.
- 14. At the intersection of Karamea Street and Elder Grove, the zone turns right to the intersection of Karamea Street and Barrett Road.
- 15. The zone turns left at the Karamea Street and Barrett Road intersection. 152 Barrett Road is in zone.
- 16. The zone proceeds south along Barrett Road to the intersection of Frankley Road. 10 Pheney Road is in zone. Tapuae Road is in zone.
- 17. At the intersection of Barrett and Frankley Roads, the zone proceeds south on Frankley Road until the intersection of Frankley and Carrington Roads. Only properties on Frankley Road between Barrett Road and Carrington Road are in zone.
- 18. The zone returns back along Frankley Road to the intersection of Barrett Road and Frankley Road and continues north along Frankley Road to the intersection of Frankley Road and Hurworth Road.
- 19. The zone turns south west onto Hurworth Road and proceeds along Hurworth Road to the intersection of Hurworth Road and Carrington Road. All properties with addresses on Hurworth Road are in zone.
- 20. The zone returns along Hurworth Road until the intersection of Frankley Road.
- 21. The zone turns north into Frankley Road and proceeds along Frankley Road until the start of the zone at the intersection of Frankley Road and Tukapa Street. Properties on the No Exit roads: Parrs Road and Patterson Road, are in zone.

Out of Zone Enrolments

Each year the board will determine the number of places which are likely to be available in the following year for the enrolment of students who live outside the home zone. The board will publish this information by notice on the school website, and in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school. The notice will indicate how applications are to be made and will specify a date by which all applications must be received. Applications for enrolment will be processed in the following order of priority, according to legislation.

- (a) first priority must be given to any applicant who is accepted for enrolment in a special programme run by the school:
- (b) second priority must be given to any applicant who is the sibling of a current student of the school:
- (c) third priority must be given to any student who is the sibling of a former student of the school:
- (d) fourth priority must be given to any applicant who is a child of a former student of the
- (e) fifth priority must be given to any applicant who is a child of an employee of the school's board or a child of a member of the school's board:

Frankley School does not have a special programme. If there are more applicants in the second, third, fourth, fifth or sixth priority groups than there are places available, selection within the priority group will be by a ballot conducted in accordance with instructions issued by the Secretary under Section 11G(1) of the Education Act 1989. Parents will be informed of the date of any ballot by notice in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school. Applicants seeking second or third priority status may be required to give proof of a sibling relationship.
